



CABINET REFINISHING CHECKLIST

PROTECTING MY HOME

- Protects my floor with moisture barrier and low tact tape
- Covers counters, walls, and anything else that will not be painted
- Builds a booth around the kitchen with negative air pressure to contain dust and overspray

COATINGS & APPLICATION

- Utilizes a top of the line finishing sprayer with ultra fine atomization to achieve a silky smooth finish
- Primes cabinets to promote adhesion, block tannins and dye migration
- Uses a low VOC waterbased industrial coating that meets or exceeds standards for durability

PROPER PREP PROCESS

- Properly cleans with a degreaser and leaves no residue
- Repairs blemishes on cabinets such as scratches and gouges
- Scuff sands all areas that will be refinished to provide proper adhesion
- Vacuums cabinets to remove any residue from sanding
- Does not caulk seams because it can cause coating failure with wood movement

INSTALLATION

- Installs all doors and drawers back to their original location
- Makes sure all doors and drawers open and close properly and are level and straight
- Cleans up after themselves
